

Addition & Subtraction Word Problems #2

1. Jamie has \$12.00 in his piggy bank saved. He wants to buy a bike for \$55.50 at Wal-Mart. How much more money does he have to save?
2. Samantha has 50 stickers of bears, 63 stickers of hearts, and 42 stickers of stars in her collection. Her goal is to have 235 stickers in her collection. Has she reached her goal yet?
3. There are 255 students in the Third grade, 349 students in the Fourth grade, and 512 students in the Fifth grade. How many more students are in the Fifth grade than the Third grade?
4. Ms. Dudley has 345 pencils in her reward box. She buys more pencils and now there are 522 pencils. How many pencils did she buy?
5. Chris has 872 papers in his notebook to take home and show his parents. He drops the notebook while he is walking home and loses 385 papers. How many papers does he still have to show his parents?
6. Rachel bought 432 lollipops in a bag to school for the party. She drops the bag and has to throw away 134 because they broke. At the party the students ate 167 lollipops. About how many lollipops are left for Rachel to take home?
